Simile: A comparison between two things using the words "Like" or "as"

Ex: I'm as hungry as a lion!

I feel sleepy like a sloth.

She was as mad as a hornet's nest.

Onomatopoeia: A
word that SOUNDS
like what it MEANS
Ex: Buzz, Snap, Sizzle,
Crackle, Whisper,
Boom, Bang, Trickle,
Jingle, Crunch



Hyperbole: An extreme exaggeration

Ex: "Steven Universe is
the best show in the
world!" "I am the
happiest girl that ever
lived." "It was the
smallest scoop of ice
cream I've ever seen."
