

# ST. MARY MAGDALENE

All four Gospels identify Mary Magdalene as one of the women who followed Jesus up Mount Calvary and stood at the foot of the cross. She was also one of those who, early Sunday morning, went to the tomb expecting to anoint His body.

Instead, she found an empty tomb, protected by an angel who revealed Jesus had risen from death. As she wept, she saw Jesus, who called her by name: "Mary." And she recognized Him, saying, "Rabboni!" which means "teacher" (Jn 20:16).

For centuries, her words to the disciples have been a source of reassurance to those who follow Jesus, the Christ: "I have seen the Lord" (Jn 20:18).

# ST. SIMON AND ST. JUDE

### October 28

St. Jude and St. Simon were first-century martyrs, identified in the Gospel as two of the Twelve Apostles. They share a feast day because, according to an ancient tradition, the two of them always traveled together, preaching the word of God.

St. Jude, also known as St. Jude Thaddeus, is invoked in desperate situations.

In the entrance antiphon of their feast day Mass we hear: "These are holy men whom the Lords chose in his own perfect love; to them he gave eternal glory." As His chosen followers, we know they must have been the kind of people Jesus needed to build His Church.

#### ABSTINENCE 🔊

Abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance.

#### FAST & ABSTINENCE 🛏

In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years (inclusive). On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Note: Those who are unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.
