Catholic Extension is seeking a mission-driven, detail-focused, relationship-oriented Director of Events and Engagement to lead the planning and execution of our most important organizational gatherings—from high-profile donor receptions and annual celebrations to board meetings and mission retreats.

This is not your typical events job. We are looking for a masterful organizer and creative problem-solver who thrives on complexity, exudes hospitality, and knows how to translate vision into seamless experiences. In this role, you will be responsible for shaping the atmosphere and logistics of our signature events that celebrate faith, foster relationships, and advance our mission across the country.

Job Responsibilities

Reporting to the Vice President of Development, the Director of Engagement and Events will:

- Lead Event Strategy and Execution: Take full ownership of CES's portfolio of events—
 from initial planning through successful completion. Events vary in size and scope and
 include donor events, board meetings, mission celebrations, national conferences, and
 milestone dinners.
- Plan with Purpose: Handle all logistics with precision, including venue selection, vendor management, catering, AV, guest accommodations, transportation, collateral, and more.

- Partner Across Teams: Collaborate with the Development and Mission departments to clarify objectives, define roles, and ensure every event is staffed and executed with precision.
- Manage Key Relationships: Serve as the meeting/event liaison to our Board of Governors, ensuring exceptional hospitality and logistical support for board meetings, dinners, and committee gatherings.
- **Support Signature Gatherings:** Manage all aspects of our biennial Mission Bishops Conference and Spirit of Francis Award Dinners—events that help to define our identity and impact.
- Oversee Event Data and Communications: Utilize our CRM system (Virtuous) to track invitations, RSVPs, and event segmentation, and coordinate collateral such as invitations, programs, and signage.
- **Ensure Fiscal Excellence:** Work with Finance and Accounts Payable on budgeting, invoicing, and vendor payments with integrity and transparency.
- Manage CES Branded Apparel: Oversee selection, inventory, and distribution of organizational apparel.
- **Be a Role Model:** Demonstrate integrity, fiscal responsibility, ethical behavior, and managerial excellence in support of CES's mission.
- Other Duties as Assigned: Remain flexible and ready to contribute wherever needed.
