ABOUT THE ROLE

With the generous support of major donors and foundations, Catholic Extension Society's Mission Department develops strategic relationships with Catholic community leaders to nurture and implement programs that transform faith communities and serve marginalized populations. Each year, Catholic Extension Society supports more than 1,200 projects, partners with dozens of organizations and universities and other organizations to expand our impact.

The Mission Team, made up of seven full-time staff reporting to the Chief Mission Officer, oversees this work in close collaboration with our colleagues in Fundraising, Marketing and Communications, and Finance. Together, we are building vibrant Catholic communities across the country to help transform hearts, lives, and society.

In this role you will:

- **Align resources with purpose**: Shape budgets and funding plans as tools for growth, ensuring that resources fuel meaningful programs and lasting change.

- **Lead with vision**: Supervise and mentor team members, establish clear goals, and foster a collaborative, high-performing Mission Team.

The role offers the opportunity to make a profound impact on economically poor communities across the U.S., working at the intersection of mission-driven leadership and transformative service. The position is based in Chicago and includes regular travel to partner dioceses and faith communities across the country.
