The Chair of Saint Peter the Apostle

FEBRUARY 22

The feast of St. Peter's Chair or "Cathedra," in Latin, dates back to the 3rd century. It reminds us of the special ministry Jesus entrusted to the Apostle Peter and his successors, to guide the Church. Peter was martyred and buried in Rome, where St. Peter's Basilica stands. His chair is represented by a bronze chair sculpted by the Renaissance artist, Bernini.

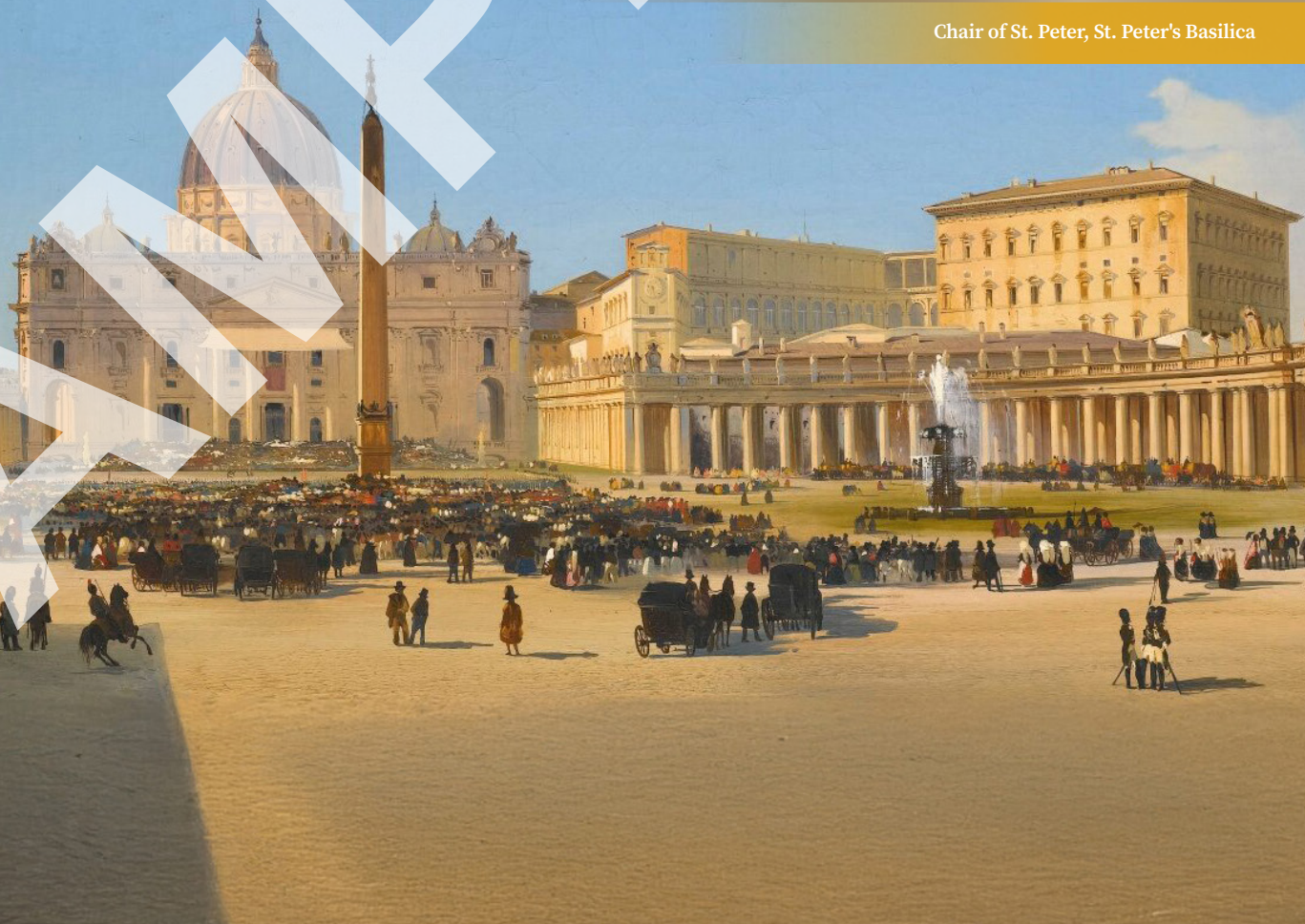

Saint Joan of Arc

MAY 30

She was a French peasant girl (1412–1431) who led the French army to victory during the Hundred Years' War. She was guided by the voice of the Lord asking her to free her people and restore faith. She was condemned as a heretic, and martyred at age 19. Her conviction was reversed 25 years later by Pope Callixtus III, and today she is celebrated as patroness of France.

With her luminous witness, St. Joan of Arc invites us to a high standard of Christian living: to make prayer the guiding motive of our days; to have full trust in doing God's will, whatever it might be.

JULY 14

She lived from 1656-1680, and is the first Native American to be canonized. Born in New York in 1656 to a Mohawk father and a Christian Algonquin mother, she was baptized at age 20. She is known for her unwavering faith even in hardship, including a bout of smallpox that scarred her face.

Leading a simple life, Kateri remained faithful to her love for Jesus, to prayer and to daily Mass. Her greatest wish was to know and to do what pleased God. She lived a life radiant with faith and purity.

In his last photo, which shows him climbing a mountain in the Val di Lanzo, with his face turned towards his goal, he wrote: "Upwards." An invitation to all of us, especially young people, not to squander our lives, but to direct them upwards and make them masterpieces.

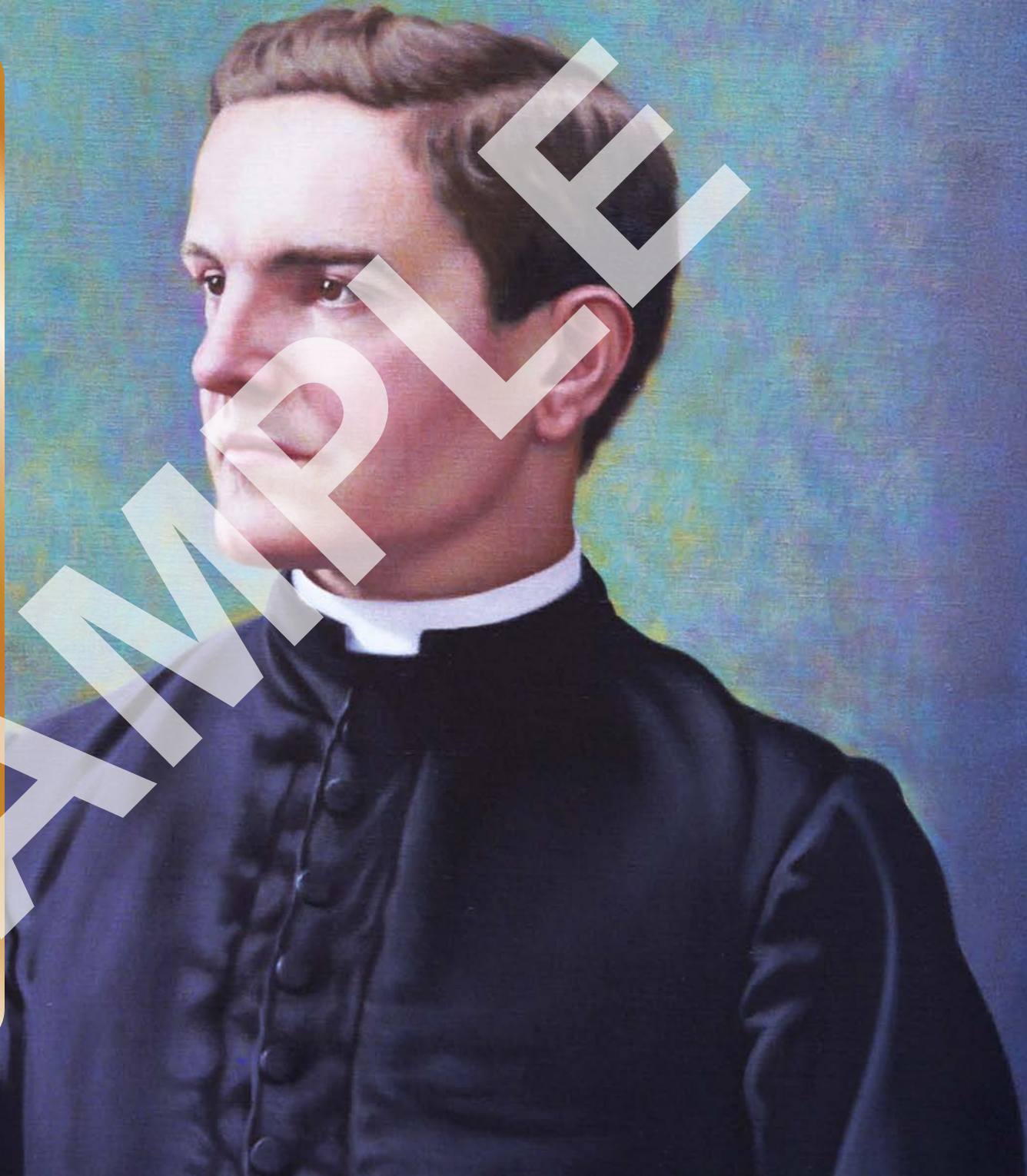
He was an American Catholic priest (1852–1890), and founder of the Knights of Columbus.

Recognizing a need in his community, in 1881 he gathered men at his New Haven, CT parish to establish this lay organization to support men with their faith and to care for the families of deceased members. He dedicated his life to serving the needy, and strengthening Catholic communities. He was beatified in 2020.

In Michael McGivney's life we see the face of a son of immigrants who gave his life in pastoral service to those most recently arrived in this country...who worked to keep families united in dignity and security; we are in the presence of an apostle who cared for victims of an epidemic before dying of the disease. We thank God for timeliness of this celebration because 130 years after his death, the brief life of this holy man speaks eloquently to our own path of holiness.

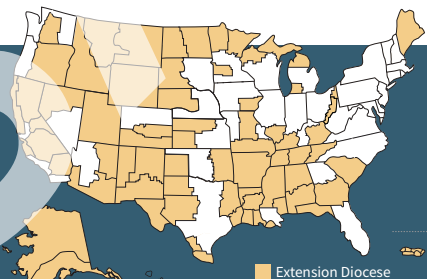

ABSTINENCE ☿

Abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance.

FAST & ABSTINENCE ☿

In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years (inclusive). On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Note: Those who are unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.
